- Liquid Waste Removal: We are licensed to handle and dispose of controlled waste, ensuring a safe and environmentally friendly service.
- Spill Response & Clean Up: Prompt and efficient service to minimise the environmental impact and ensure safety compliance after a spillage incident.
- Pit Eduction: Clearing and cleaning of pits using vacuum suction, ensuring proper maintenance and reducing the risk of blockages.
- Industrial Vacuum Loading: High-capacity vacuum loading service for various industrial applications, such as the removal of waste products or materials.
- Garnet Waste Removal Service (Liquid and Dry Garnet): Specialised removal of liquid and dry garnet waste, ensuring safe and environmentally compliant disposal for industrial and blasting applications.


WHERE WE OPERATE

 - **June 2024** iVac takes delivery of 3 new trucks Vacvator, Vac Dig and Mudvac bringing the fleet to 10 Trucks.
 - August 2024- Started in the mining industry. iVac has its first mining job with Rio Tinto at Brockman 2, and the same month deployed staff working for Chevron on Barrow Island to assist on the WA oil project.
 - **September 2024** Delivery due for 2024 STG Dangerous Goods Rated HDV800 Truck.
- October 2024 Took delivery of 2 new KingVac 11000 Trucks, with one more due mid 2025.
- **2025 -** iVac working on expansion into to Sydney NSW.

2023 + 2024 + 2x 2025 Kingvac / Volvo

The Kingvac truck is a robust vacuum loader designed for Australia's demanding conditions. It features an 8,000-litre debris tank and a powerful Robuschi tri-lobe vacuum pump with 6500 m³/h airflow and 27" Hg vacuum levels. It offers top-tier vacuum power and advanced filtration, making it ideal for fine powders and heavy products over long distances. This versatile truck excels in both liquid and solid waste management, making it a reliable choice for industrial and environmental cleanup projects.

At iVac WA, our fleet is the backbone of our operations, featuring a diverse range of state-of-the-art vacuum trucks and excavation equipment. Each vehicle is meticulously maintained and equipped with the latest technology, ensuring we deliver efficient, safe, and reliable services across Western Australia. 2024 Vacvator / Hino

The Vacvator TMC76-245B is a high-performance hydro excavation vacuum truck designed for efficiency, versatility, and power. As our second most powerful truck, it delivers 4150 m³/h suction power with vacuum pressure up to -28" Hg, making it excellent for handling fine and heavy powders over longer distances. Built on a Hino FM2632 6x4 chassis, its compact size allows access to limited spaces while maintaining top performance. The truck's high-pressure NDD system, intelligent CAN bus management, and advanced filtration ensure precise, safe, and efficient operation, making it ideal for complex vacuum excavation tasks.



2024 Mudvac / Volvo

The Mudvac truck is designed for efficient liquid and mud waste removal. With a 10,000L capacity, it handles large-scale tasks effortlessly. Its powerful liquid ring pump fills the truck in just 3.5 minutes and offers reverse operation for precise waste disposal, making it ideal for IBC containers or relocating liquids. Built tough, the Mudvac manages everything from septic tanks to drill mud with ease. Its advanced fresh water system and durable construction ensure reliable performance for various industrial and environmental applications, handling heavy sludge and other waste efficiently and safely.



2024 + 2019 Vac Dig / Hino

The Vac Dig truck is engineered for precision and versatility in vacuum excavation projects. It boasts a 7,000L debris tank and a 3,000L water capacity, making it ideal for handling both wet and dry materials during excavation tasks. The high-efficiency vacuum system, combined with a powerful water pump, ensures excellent performance for non-destructive digging (NDD). With a hydraulically operated boom, the Vac Dig truck excels in confined and hard-to-reach areas, delivering precise excavation with minimal environmental impact. Its advanced filtration systems effectively control dust and debris, making it a versatile choice for pit work and other challenging excavation projects.



2024 STG /Isuzu

The STG Combo Vacuum Truck is a versatile, dual-function unit engineered for both high-performance jetting and vacuum recovery. Equipped with a 260L/min jetter and wet/dry vacuum capability, it's ideal for clearing large stormwater lines, culverts, and pits while simultaneously recovering debris and liquid waste. With powerful suction performance and an integrated high-pressure water system, the STG handles everything from routine drain maintenance to emergency blockages with efficiency and speed. Its compact yet robust design makes it suitable for both urban and industrial environments, delivering safe, effective results on complex infrastructure projects.

MAJOR PROJECTS



iVac WA has played a pivotal role in several major projects across Western Australia, including the Tonkin Gap Project, Metronet, and Midland Brick operations. Our involvement in these projects highlights our commitment to excellence, utilising our advanced vacuum technology and expert team to deliver precise and efficient solutions.

Perth Airport Redevelopment: Assisting in the Perth Airport redevelopment, including the construction of a new terminal and parallel runway, iVac WA's expertise is crucial in maintaining the integrity of underground utilities and minimising disruptions during construction. This project, the largest private infrastructure investment in Perth's history, will significantly enhance WA's aviation capacity, supporting future growth in tourism and the resources sector.

Acacia Prison Project: Performed critical vacuum excavation and potholing services for the installation of footings along the new fence line at Acacia Prison. This work ensured precision and safety in a highly regulated environment, contributing to the secure and stable construction of the facility's perimeter.

Midland Junction Alliance (ongoing): Ongoing provision of vacuum excavation services for the Midland Junction Alliance, supporting various infrastructure projects in the area and on the new Midland Train Station. Our work ensures precise excavation with minimal disruption, maintaining the integrity of surrounding utilities and structures.

We're regularly called upon for urgent after-hours jobs, including burst wastewater pipe containment, flood prevention, and critical infrastructure support. Midland Brick

We have an ongoing contract with Midland Brick to provide regular vacuum truck services across their production facility. Our team is onsite multiple times a week to clean conveyor lines and manage dust buildup, with monthly dump station cleanouts and annual removal of dust from silo tops and roof areas to reduce operational risks and maintain plant efficiency.
